

Turkmenistan

Turkmenistan is consistently developing its transport system: a modern seaport and logistics center in Turkmenbashi, as well as the Ashgabat International Airport, have been built and commissioned. Multi-lane highways are being constructed in the East-West and North-South directions. On April 10, 2026, with the participation of President of Turkmenistan Serdar Berdimuhamedov, the new Mary – Turkmenabat section was officially opened to traffic, marking the commissioning of the highway from the capital to the border with Uzbekistan.

Six international transport corridor development projects, with a total investment of **\$6.05 billion**, are being implemented or planned by 2035.



Figure 1. Distribution of investments in the development of the Eurasian Transport Network by mode of transport, \$bn.

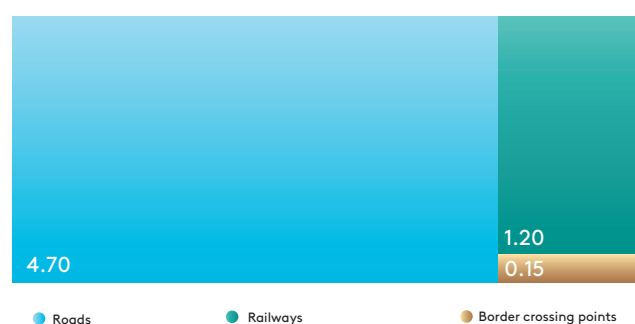


Figure 2. Distribution of investments by stages of investment projects, \$bn.

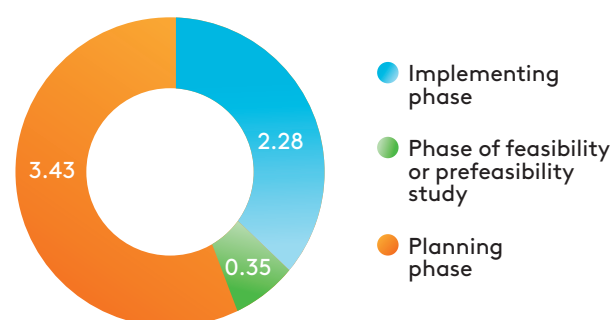


Figure 3. Investments in the development of transport corridors in Turkmenistan, \$bn.

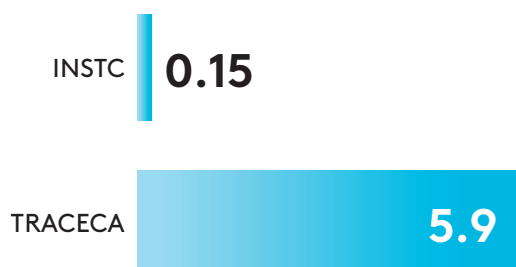


Figure 4. Distribution of projects by funding sources, number of projects

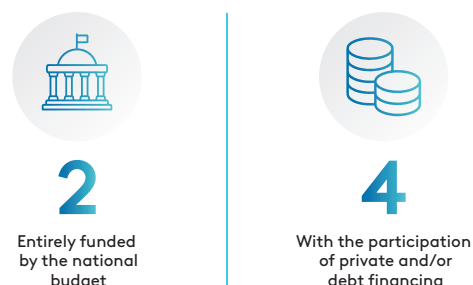
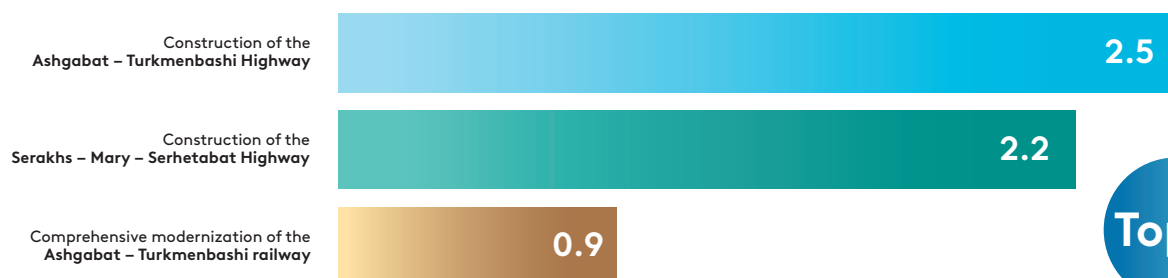


Figure 5. Top 3 projects for the development of transport corridors in Turkmenistan by investment volume, \$bn.
